A day tour with an early start and late finish...to the Darling Downs and *Dad & Dave* territory, visiting an Installation in the middle of nowhere dedicated to the great story-teller Steele Rudd, followed by Lunch at the historic Rudd's Pub at Nobby and a visit to the museum acknowledging the work of Sister Elizabeth Kenny. A few 'detours' along the way complete a day filled with Knowledge and Fun!

BRIBIE THE BASKET-MAKER – AND MORE

Many remember Moreton Bay chronicler Thomas Welsby's book on *Bribie the Basket-Maker* and this is "just the tip of the Iceberg" for there is much on this Island to experience. Following a general orientation, the tour joins the *Ferryman* for a morning coffee cruise of the Pumicestone Passage There will then be time to visit the local Arts & Crafts Community before Lunch at the local RSL. From there it is a short walk to the Buckley's Hole Conservation Park, home to migratory birds from all around the world. Upon returning to Brisbane, we make a detour to visit the Abbey Museum of Art & Archaeology.

QUIRKY BRISBANE

...a Time Ball, Bare-Chested Ladies & a whole lot more

When it comes to an understanding of the history to be found in Brisbane's CBD, there is no historian better equipped to seek out the 'quirky' than David Gibson. This tour focuses on those accoutrements to the City of Brisbane that make Brisbane different to the other metropolises in the world. There is some walking and detours are planned to a number of Custodians of Brisbane's rich historical Legacy.

PLACES OF REFLECTION

Greater Brisbane is home to any number of powerful Stories and Memorials that chart the Sense of Sacrifice of Men and Women who saw service in Conflicts beyond our shore. This tour will visit several places of reflection, including the oldest Memorial to The Great War in Brisbane and an external view of a onetime War Memorial Hospital.

RIPARIAN RENDEZVOUS

From the earliest of times, a river on a flood plain has been a feature of the present-day boundaries of Greater Brisbane and, indeed, it became something of a magnet for European settlement from the 1820's. This is a tour of two parts – an actual cruise with commentary upon the Brisbane River, with the second part of the tour devoted to riverside vistas and structures on the banks of the present-day Brisbane River.
